

## TOUR ITINERARY

**Saturday (2/18)** – Depart Orlando for Amsterdam and connecting flight to Israel.

**Sunday (2/19)** – Arrive at Ben-Gurion airport in Tel Aviv and transfer to the Metropolitan hotel in downtown Tel Aviv.

**Monday (2/20)** – Walking tour of Tel Aviv.

**Tuesday (2/21)** - Travel south to Joppa and take a walking tour through the ancient city, visiting archeological sites in Joppa. Then, we travel north to the Museum of the Diaspora at Tel Aviv University. Here we will study the history of the dispersion. After lunch, we will travel north to Caesarea to the Roman and Crusader ruins. Then, we continue north to the fortress of Megiddo which overlooks the Jezreel Valley. Then, we climb the ascent to Nazareth and travel through Cana to Tiberias (on the shores of the Sea of Galilee). We will stay here overnight at the Jordan River Hotel in Tiberias.

**Wednesday (2/22)** - On this day we will focus on the ministry of Messiah Jesus in the vicinity of the Sea of Galilee. We will pray together on the Mount of Beatitudes. We will visit the ancient synagogue at Capernaum. We will cross the Sea by boat and enjoy lunch at Kibbutz Ein Gev. Later, we will travel to the Jordan River for a special baptismal service. Then, we will travel north through the Hula Valley to Metulla and stay overnight at the Arazin Hotel.

**Thursday (2/23)** - This day we will visit sites in Upper Galilee and Golan Heights. We will visit Syrian bunkers, which will demonstrate the significance of this area to the defense of northern Israel. We will also visit Kiryat Shemona, Tel Dan, Caesarea Philippi, Mt. Hermon, Kunitra, then go to our hotel at Kibbutz Ein Gev on the Sea of Galilee.

**Friday (2/24)** - Depart for Jerusalem. On the way we will visit Bet She'an as we travel down the Jordan Valley. Then, make our ascent up the mountains to Jerusalem, arriving at Kings Hotel in time for Shabbat. We will go to the Western Wall for prayer.

## TOUR ITINERARY, continued

**Saturday (2/25)** - We will celebrate the Lord's Shabbat in Jerusalem. A walking tour of Jerusalem with Zev Bar-Tov of the Temple Mount Faithful group will be available for those interested.

**Sunday (2/26)** - This day will be spent considering the history of Jerusalem. We will visit the Holy Land model of Jerusalem during the 2nd Temple era, the Temple Mount, the Jewish Quarter of the Old City, Hezekiah's wall, and the Tower of David Museum.

**Monday (2/27)** - On our third day in Jerusalem we will retrace the steps of Messiah Jesus in Jerusalem. Visiting the Mt. of Olives, Gethsemane, the Antonia Fortress, the Church of the Holy Sepulcher, and the Garden Tomb.

**Tuesday (2/28)** - We will visit settlements around Jerusalem in Judea and Samaria. We will view the environs of Jerusalem from Samuel's Tomb, travel north to Shiloh to visit the synagogue there built in the fashion of the Tabernacle of Moses. We will visit friends first in Kedumin then in Kiryat Arba, where we will pray at the Cave of Machpelah. Then, we will return to our hotel in Jerusalem.

**Wednesday (3/1)** - We will travel south into the Judean Wilderness to Masada. On our return trip to Jerusalem we will visit the springs at Ein Gedi, the Dead Sea, and Qumran.

**Thursday (3/2)** - On our final day in the Land, we will visit sites in Jerusalem relevant to modern Israel including the Knesset, Yad Vashem, and the Israel Museum. We will have a final tour dinner with our guide and driver.

**Friday (3/3)** - We leave Jerusalem for the airport in Tel Aviv and our flight back to the US. We will change flights in Amsterdam and proceed to Orlando.

## Travel Arrangements and Conditions

**Transportation.** Fly from Orlando on Martin Airlines to Amsterdam to make connecting flight to Tel Aviv on KLM airlines. Fly jet economy class. Cancellation fees levied by the airlines are applicable if you cancel or change your airline ticket for any reason after it is purchased. Ticketing must be completed 60 days prior to departure. In Israel, an air conditioned bus will be provided for the tour group.

**Hotels:** - The tour group will be staying at the hotels listed on the itinerary. Hotel rates are calculated on the basis of double occupancy. Single accommodation costs extra.

**Meals:** The tour includes two (2) meals per day. Breakfast and dinner are served at the hotels. Lunch will be eaten along the way. Each individual is responsible for their own lunch.

**Tips & Fees:** Entrance fees for sites listed in the itinerary are included in tour package. Tips and airport taxes are included. Tips to guides, driver, hotel porters, maids and waiters are included. On the last night we will receive an offering for our driver and guide as an expression of our appreciation and love for them.

**Baggage:** Two (2) bags are allowed on the flights to and from Israel. You are also allowed a carry-on bag small enough to fit under your seat.

**Not Included:** Passports, visa fees, health documentation costs, daily lunch, food and beverages not usually included with meals, optional sightseeing tours and excursions, accident and baggage insurance, transportation and handling of excess luggage, tips for special personal services, items of purely personal nature such as laundry, telephone, room service, cable, etc.

**Passport:** A valid passport is required and must be obtained by each tour member. Complete instructions and applications can be obtained by contacting your local agency.

**Deposits & Payments:** A deposit of \$100 is due on November 15, 2005. An additional \$900 is due before December 15, 2005. The final payment of \$1050 is due by January 15, 2006.
